Series Description

This series consists of files of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) NASA Administrator, Daniel S. Goldin. He was the ninth administrator and NASA's longest-serving. He started a vigorous campaign to make the agency's products "faster, better, cheaper". During his tenure he managed the Mars Pathfinder, Hubble Space Telescope servicing missions, and the International Space Station. Records contain materials reflecting policy studies and analysis; files on program development and management; correspondence, and memoranda between NASA officials, private sources, and other U.S. Government agencies; correspondence on his nomination as NASA Administrator; calendars; records of official meetings, trips, and subject files; speeches given before various organizations; Town Hall Meetings; and "Faster,

Better, Cheaper” initiative material; disposition of personal papers; resignation and post-NASA activities. Specifically, this subject contains photographs; correspondence files; articles and news clippings; press conferences; and speeches.

General Notes

Daniel S. Goldin’s personal papers are held in the National Archives at College Park. Speeches held by the HRC have been digitized and placed on the public DMS. Goldin’s oral histories held in the HRC are currently available upon request.
