This series consists of files of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) Chief of Manned Space Flight (1958-1964), Manned Spacecraft Center (MSC) Deputy Center Director (1964-1967), Manager of Apollo Spacecraft Program Office (ASPO) (1967-1969), and NASA Deputy Administrator (1969-1976) George M. Low. Records contain materials primarily from his tenures as Manager of ASPO and NASA Deputy Administrator reflecting policy studies and analysis; files on program development; correspondence, and memoranda between NASA officials, private sources, and other U.S. Government agencies; records of official meetings; and speeches given before various organizations. Specifically, this series contains correspondence files; oral histories; speeches; congressional briefings and budget files;

Apollo program; Apollo-Soyuz Test Project (ASTP); and early development of the Space Shuttle program.

George Low's personal papers are held by the Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (RPI) Archives and Special Collections. Speeches held by the HRC have been digitized and placed on the public DMS. Low's oral histories held in the HRC have been digitized and are currently available upon request.
